Year 7	Intent In year 7, we introduce students to the foundations of language learning. Due to inconsistencies of language teaching in our feeder primary schools, we aim to ensure that all students have been given the same opportunities at the start of their language learning journey. We begin by learning how to introduce ourselves and others with a focus on pronunciation. Students begin to form short sentences verbally and in written form, which over time will lead to short paragraphs and conversations. We then deliver topics that students can relate to when talking about themselves e.g. where they live, their family, free-time activities. Each topic is sequenced to allow for subject knowledge and particularly grammatical knowledge to be revisited and developed. We provide numerous opportunities to identify and fill any learning gaps via assessment through questioning, focussed assessments, review lessons, vocabulary, comprehension tasks and grammar activities.
