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If there are problems or concerns the following chart should be used as a guide. The first point of contact should be with the member of staff closest to the problem. We are pleased to note that most problems are quickly resolved at this point.

Guidelines

- 1. You should write to, or telephone, the relevant member of staff. If telephoning, all staff can be contacted through the main switchboard on 01827 831300. Mr Foskett can be contacted through headteacher@wilnecotehighschool.org.
- 2. If you are contacting a teacher by telephone, you will probably find that s/he will be teaching. Please leave a message and you will be contacted as soon as possible.
- 3. On receipt of a telephone call, or letter/email, staff will contact you within 48 hours to indicate their preliminary action.
- 4. Investigations can take time, but it is hoped that a fuller investigation/report to parents will be ready within 10 school days.
- 5. Governors can be contacted by writing a letter addressed to Mr M Howell, Chair of Governors and sent via the school office.
